NATION'S LARGEST HEALTH COALITION CONTINUES TO EXPAND AS CONCERN GROWS

According to a Kaiser Family Foundation poll, more Americans are concerned about being able to pay for health care and health insurance than they are about losing their jobs, paying their rent or mortgage, losing money in the stock market, or being the victim of a terrorist attack.
